COMMITMENTS:

- Attend session with child (make-up sessions offered)
- 10 hours annual **Family Education Time (FET)***, including:
 - Attend Playgroups Orientation (mandatory for new families)
 - Attend 2 DPNS Association meetings (mandatory)
 - Evening Parent Classes
- 3 to 4 hours annual task time (e.g., making play dough for site, assisting Director with set-up and clean-up)

Families with more than one child enrolled in DPNS programs may be eligible for a reduction in certain requirements.

VOLUNTARY INVOLVEMENT:

- Fundraising events
- Session / Association Jobs
- Special Projects

FEES: Partial tuition assistance may be available.

Due April 1st:

- \$10 application fee (non-refundable)

Due June 1st:

- Deposit equal to one month's tuition (non-refundable)
- \$25 DPNS Association fee (non-refundable)

Due at start of school:

- Sep – Dec tuition
- \$25 Adult Ed Fee per registered adult

³FAMILY EDUCATION TIME (FET)

DPNS is an Adult Education class in the Davis Joint Unified School District. Parent participation hours acquired through parent attendance at DPNS-sponsored or scheduled educational programs and lectures, extra participation or observation days, and other DPNS Director-supervised events during the school year.
